Re: Massachusetts “Right to Repair” and car data access, control**

Bethesda, MD – Below is the official *Your Car. Your Data. Your Choice.*™ campaign statement in response to attempts to distort the campaign’s mission and sow confusion among car owners and drivers nationwide, especially those who live and work in Massachusetts.

“We believe car owners and drivers should have direct access to and control of the data their cars collect.

Providing consumers with control of their car data ensures their right to choose the price, place and person they want for repair and maintenance services, whether that is at an independent or dealership repair center. More than 14,500 people nationwide — car enthusiasts, auto DIY-ers, parents, consumer rights and privacy advocates, among others — share this sentiment and have signed a [petition](#) demanding Congress give car owners access to and control of their car data.

We assure consumers in Massachusetts and nationwide that we’re committed to pursuing a gateway for accessing car data that is cyber secure, standardized and direct. Simply put: it’s your car, it should be your data.”
